

STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT (2021-22)

CHARUSAT believes that there is a substantial relationship between students' satisfaction and academic excellence. A student satisfaction survey is conducted on regular basis to measure students' satisfaction with their educational experience, establishing a measurable benchmark in areas such as curriculum, facilities, and access to academic resources, as well as the quality and availability of extracurricular activities. The survey includes the NAAC-recommended questionnaire to improve higher education quality. A student must respond to all the questions by selecting the most appropriate of the five responses given in the following format with her/his sincere effort and thought. The questionnaire is divided into two parts: 1) Teacher specific for a particular course, and 2) Institute/Institution specific. Furthermore, a qualitative question is included to provide the student an opportunity for providing suggestions or improvements and mention weaknesses of the institute concerning the teaching-learning process. The questions, as well as the responses given by the students, are as follow:

The students provided a variety of recommendations to enhance the general quality of teaching and learning. The majority of the students stated their satisfaction with the university's approaches to teaching, learning, and evaluation. However, several elements were prioritized by the students, including the need to increase hands-on learning opportunities, emphasize research-oriented activities, increase chances for student exchange programs with other institutions, and promote business opportunities.

Thus, in general, the students expressed their satisfaction with an overall satisfaction score of 8.9 on a scale of 10.
